<u>Day 1 - Sunday, November 29</u>	TRANSFERS TO THE NEW YORK PIER - DEPARTURE 4:00 PM	
<u>Day 2 - Monday, November 30</u>	AT SEA

<u>Day 4 - Wednesday, December 2</u>	PUERTO PLATA, DR RICO	(10:00 AM - 6:00 PM)
Puerto Plata is the ninth largest city in the Dominican Republic and the capital of the province of Puerto Plata. For spectacular city views, take a ride up the Pico Isabel de Torres mountain which stands over 2,600 feet high. History buff? Visit Fortaleza San Felipe, which was built in the 16 th century and served as a prison under the dictatorship of Rafael Trujillo. Or head to the Amber Museum, a museum filled with a unique collection of valuable Dominican amber which is semiprecious tree sap that has hardened for millions of years capturing many fossils of plant and insect life.

<u>Day 6 - Friday, December 4</u>	WILLEMSTAD, CURACAO	(8:00 AM - 6:00 PM)
Walk around this quaint harbor town and you'll think you've traveled back in time to Old Amsterdam. Admire the colorful Dutch architecture and take advantage of the excellent shopping. Relax on a 17-century veranda with a drink made with the famous Curacao liqueur.		
<u>Day 7 - Saturday, December 5</u>	ORANJESTAD, ARUBA	(8:00 AM - 6:00 PM)
Incredibly white sands and cobalt blue seas make the small island of Aruba a popular destination. In the bustling freeport town of Oranjestad, sherbet colored Dutch colonial buildings, draped in bougainvillea, oleander and hibiscus are simply picturesque. Small, but informative museums relate the island's history.

Admire the stunning bays of Santa Marta and popular beaches. Explore the ancient cultures of the Taironas who occupied the land thousands of years ago. Stroll over to the Cathedral and admire its beautiful architecture and learn about its history.		
<u>Day 9 - Monday, December 7</u>	CARTAGENA, COLOMBIA	(6:00 AM - 2:00 PM)
The old walled city of Cartagena reflects a turbulent history of conquistadors and pirates. Climb "las murallas" for an unforgettable view of the harbor. Shop for emeralds and leather goods along the cobblestone streets of this enchanting city.
